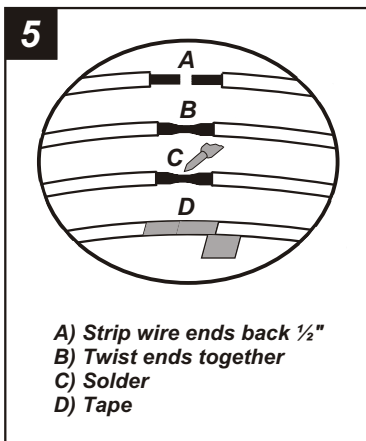


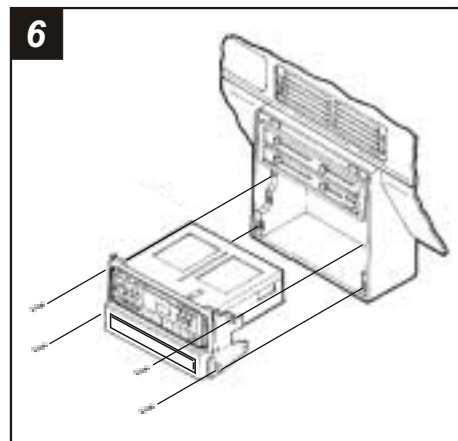
2-SHAFT HEAD UNITS: Attach the **Faceplate** to the **Radio Housing**. Slide the aftermarket head unit into the kit and secure with shaft nuts. (see Fig. A)

DIN HEAD UNITS: Cut and remove the shaft supports. Slide the DIN cage into the **Radio Housing** and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. Slide the aftermarket head unit into the cage until secure. (see Fig. B)

(If an equalizer will be included, slide the unit into the back of the **Radio Housing** and secure. If an equalizer will NOT be included, snap the **Equalizer Dummy Plate** into the opening).

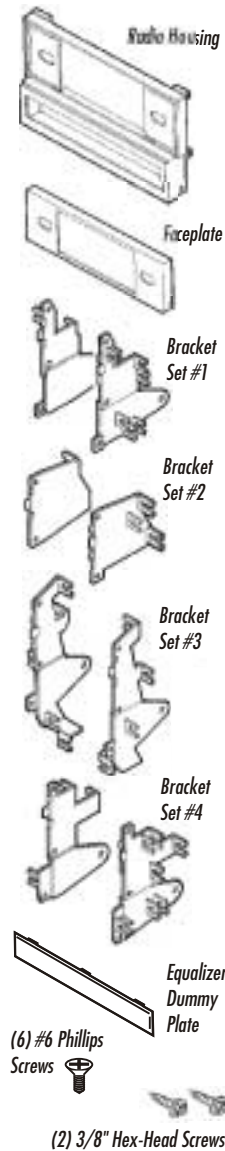


Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adaptor and making connections as shown. (Isolate and individually tape off the ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit).



Re-connect the battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation. Mount the head unit/kit assembly to the sub-dash with those screws previously removed.

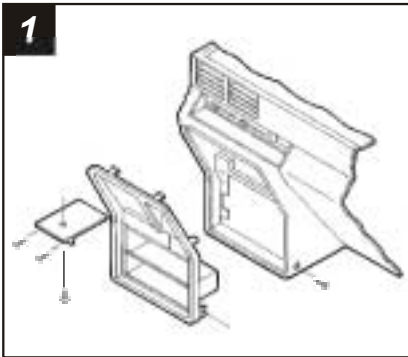

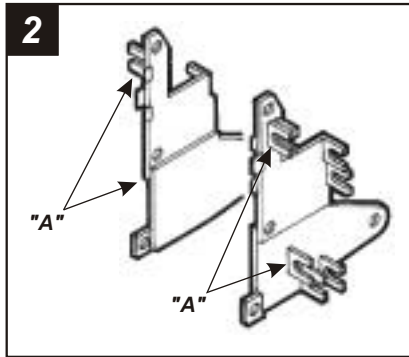

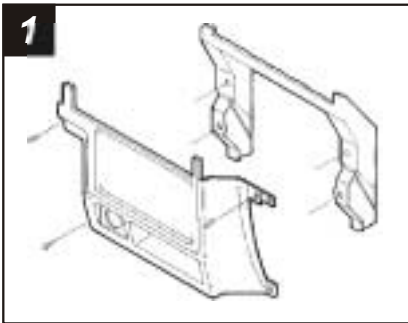


Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Remove the ashtray and (3) screws from the ashtray bracket. Remove (1) screw from each side of the dash console and unsnap the trim bezel.

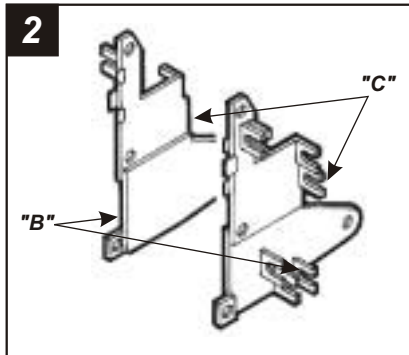

TOYOTA 4Runner 1989-95

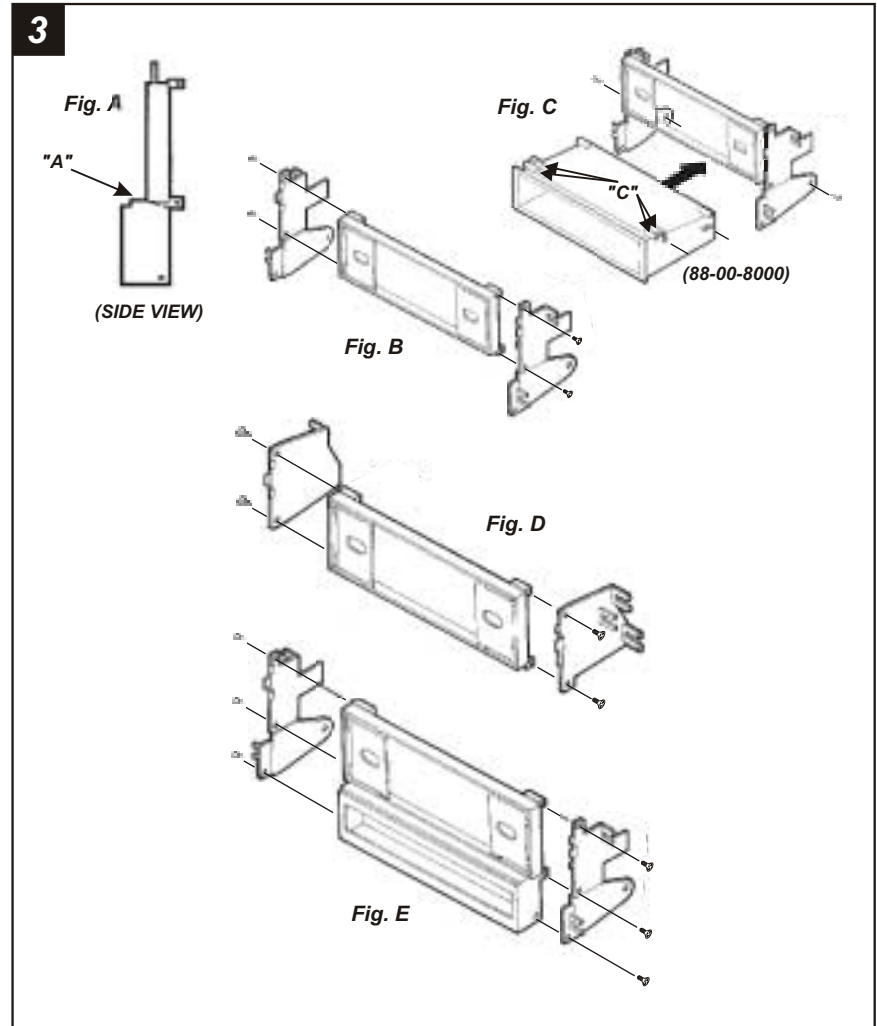


Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Remove the driver's side speaker panel by removing (3) screws and (1) 10mm bolt. Remove (1) screw from the left side of the housing and unsnap the ignition cover. Remove the glove compartment assembly by removing (1) 10mm bolt from the bottom of the speaker panel and (3) screws from the right side of the housing. Remove the remaining (3) screws securing the radio trim bezel.



Cut and remove all mounting tabs on **Bracket Set #1** EXCEPT top tabs "C" and bottom tabs "B". The mounting tabs can be identified by the stamped letter on the back of each tab. Skip to the Installation Instructions for ALL VEHICLES on Page #10.

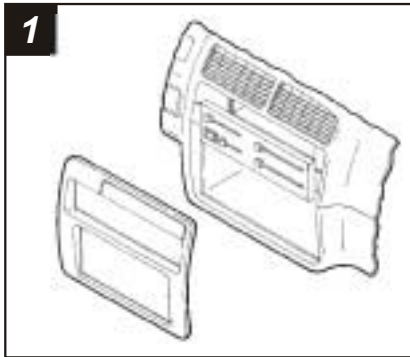


POCKET RETENTION: Cut a diagonal score line on each side of the **Radio Housing** ("A"), break away the bottom portion of the Housing and discard. (see Fig. A) Mount the Brackets to the converted Radio Housing with (4) #6 Phillips Screws. (see Fig. B) Order Metra's 88-00-8000, cut and remove sockets "C" and mount the pocket to the Brackets with (2) 3/8" Hex-Head Screws and (2) locator pins. (see Fig. C)

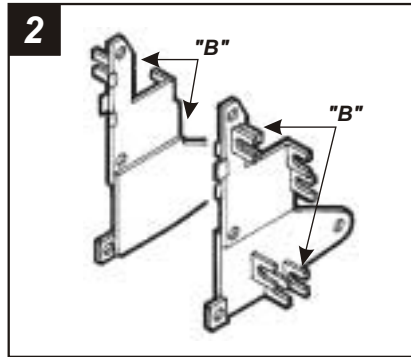
UPPER DASH COROLLA APPLICATIONS: Cut a diagonal score line on each side of the **Radio Housing**, break away the bottom portion of the Housing and discard. (see Fig. A) Mount the Brackets to the converted Radio Housing with (4) #6 Phillips Screws. (see Fig. D)

ALL OTHER APPLICATIONS: Mount the Brackets to the **Radio Housing** with (6) #6 Phillips Screws. (see Fig. E)

TOYOTA T100 1993-98

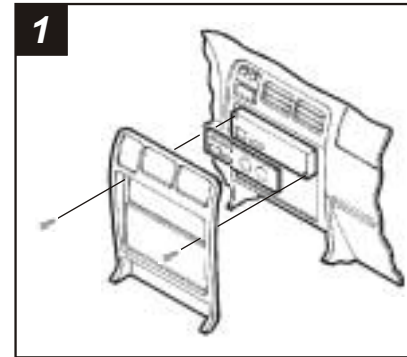

Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Pull the cupholder out and unsnap the trim bezel from the dash. Remove (4) screws securing the factory head unit and disconnect the wiring.

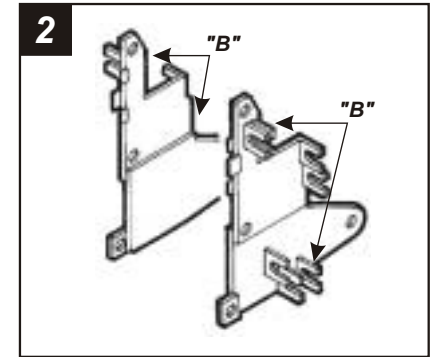

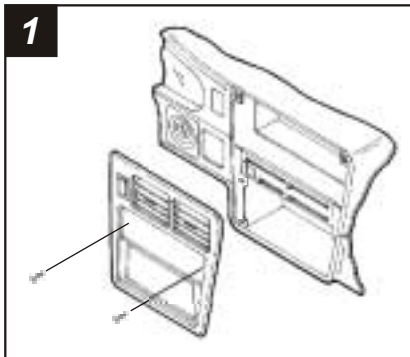

Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Open the center armrest door. Unsnap the parking brake trim panel to access the gear shifter trim panel. Unsnap the gear shifter trim panel and remove. Remove the climate control knobs. Remove the climate control trim plate and (2) Phillips screws exposed. Unclip the radio trim bezel and remove. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the factory head unit and disconnect the wiring.

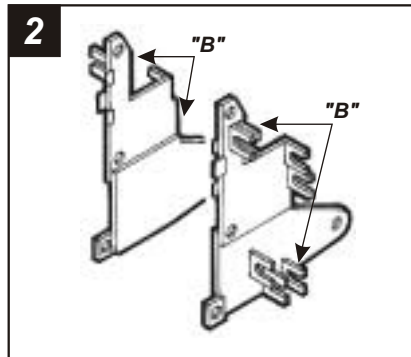

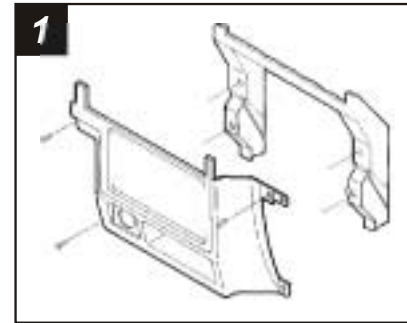


Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Remove (2) screws from the lower steering column panel and remove. Remove the (2) screws exposed on the radio trim bezel. Open the glove box and remove (1) screw and (1) bolt exposed. Remove (2) screws from the ashtray cavity and (2) screws from the bracket. Remove (2) screws from each lower side of the trim bezel and unsnap the bezel.

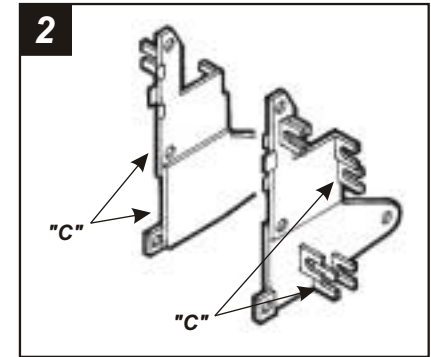

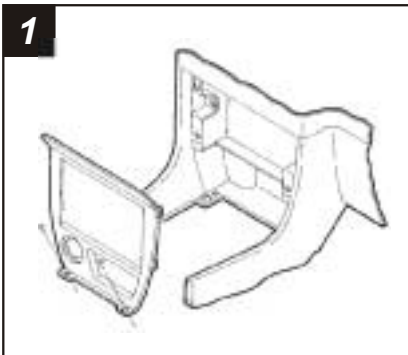


Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit. Remove the driver's side speaker panel by removing (3) screws and (1) 10mm bolt. Remove (1) screw from the left side of the housing and unsnap the ignition cover. Remove the glove compartment assembly by removing (1) 10mm bolt from the bottom of the speaker panel and (3) screws from the right side of the housing. Remove the remaining (3) screws securing the radio trim bezel.

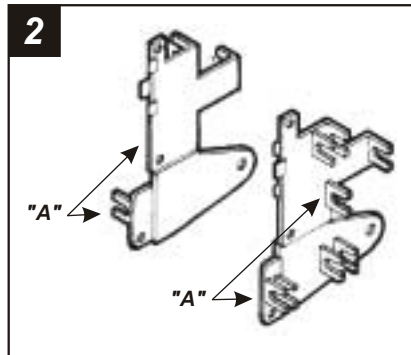

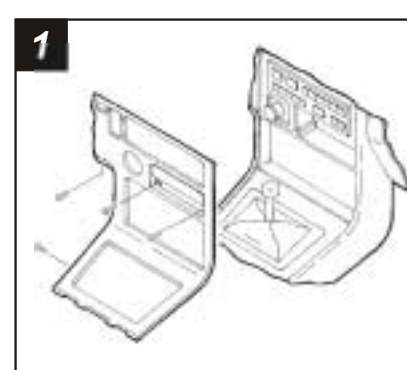

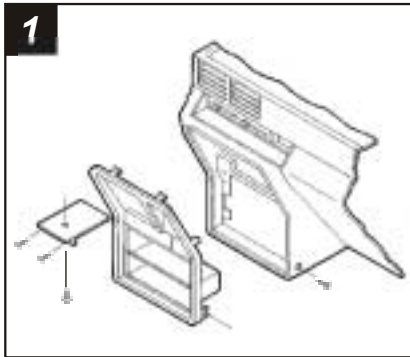

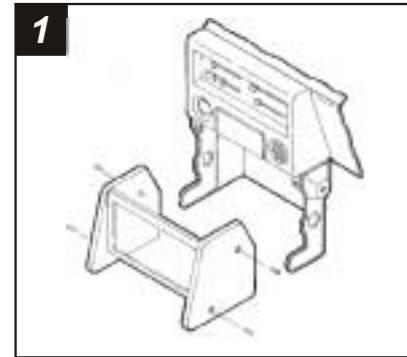

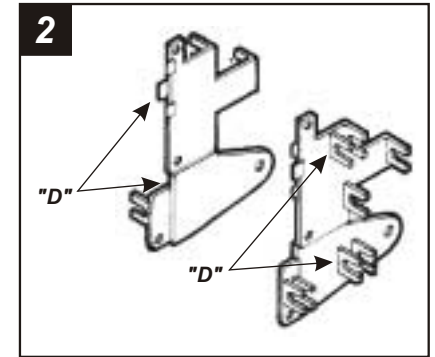

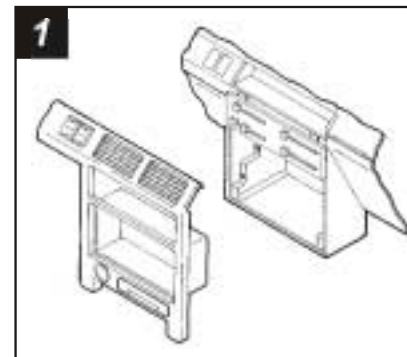

Remove the glove compartment assembly by removing (1) 10mm bolt from the bottom of the speaker panel and (3) screws from the right side of the housing. Remove the remaining (3) screws securing the radio trim bezel.

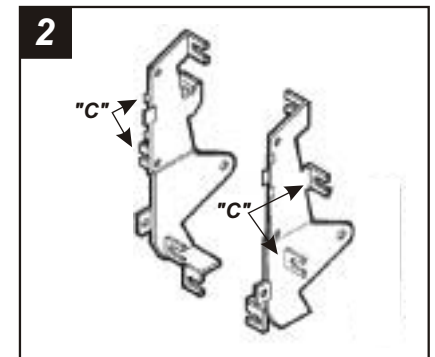

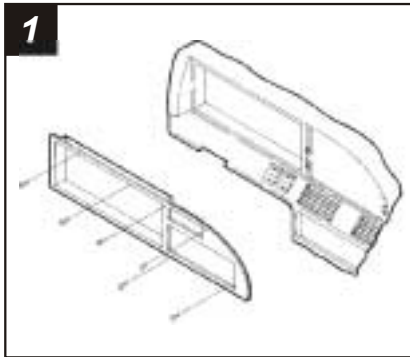

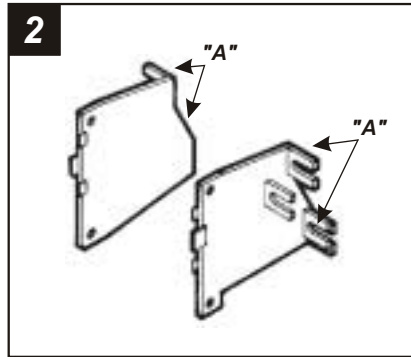

TOYOTA Corolla (sed/wag-upper dash) 1988-92

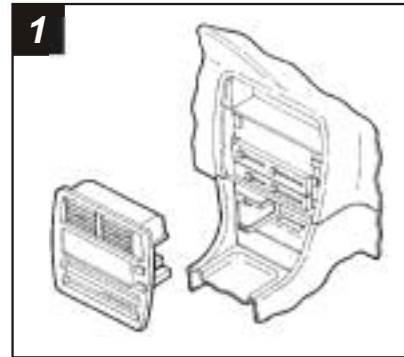

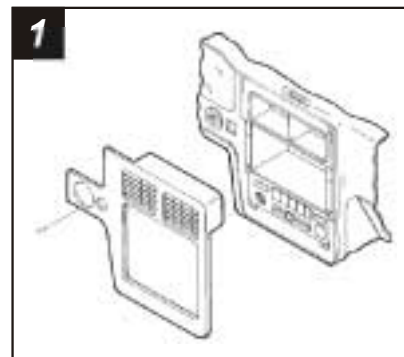

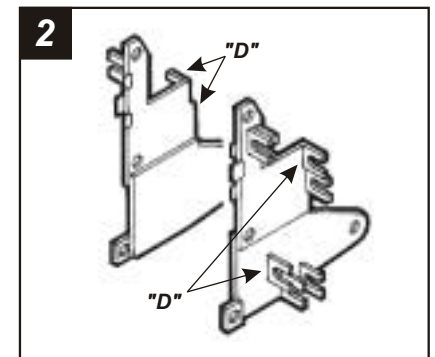
